

Stutz Artists Association to host Holiday Exhibition on November 16

INDIANAPOLIS (June 12, 2007) – The Stutz Artists Association will host its annual holiday exhibition on Friday, Nov. 16. More than 30 artists with studios in the historic Stutz building will display their work together in one room from 5:00 p.m. to 10 p.m. during the popular event. While browsing, visitors will enjoy light refreshments and music.

Holiday gift ideas at the show will range from paintings, metal sculpture and wearable art to jewelry, pewter chess sets and custom portraits.

The myriad artists who make up the Stutz Artists Association all share the common love of art but widely diverge from there. They are photographers, painters, sculptors, silversmiths and illustrators. They are a variety of ages, ethnicities and backgrounds. Some have advanced degrees in art, and others advance their art in degrees. Some teach classes and hold workshops, and others mentor one-to-one. Some produce work that's accessible to a broad audience and sell a large amount of work, while others focus on work that's purely for their own enjoyment. Many of the Stutz artists have artwork in permanent collections at museums, schools and hospitals. Some are regional and even national award winners.

The Stutz Artists Association is one of the largest associations of working artists in Indiana. It exists to encourage its member artists and to promote their work.

Housing the largest group of artists under one roof in the Midwest, the exterior of the yellow brick buildings that comprise the complex have changed little since the Stutz motor car was made here. Located on an entire city block in downtown Indianapolis, the interior of the 400,000-square-foot former car factory has been renovated into studios and office space. The Stutz is now home to more than 75 artists, sculptors, photographers, designers, architects and craftsmen.
